JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to this Court's order entered on August 21, 2008, attorney for Plaintiffs and attorneys for Defendants respectfully submit this joint status report to inform the Court of the status of HR 6034 and S. 3369. Both parties agree that there has been little significant movement on HR 6034: (1) on May 13, 2008, HR 6034 was referred to the House Committee on the Judiciary, (2) on June 3, 2008, HR 6034 was referred to the Subcommittee on Immigration, Citizenship, Refugees, Border Security, and International Law, (3) on July 10, 2008, a subcommittee consideration and mark-up session was held and HR 6034 was forwarded by subcommittee to full committee by voice vote, (4) on July 16, 2008, a committee consideration and mark-up session was held and HR 6034 was ordered to be reported (Amended) by voice vote, (5) on October 3, 2008, HR 6034 was reported (Amended) by the committee on the Judiciary and HR 6034 was placed on the Union Calendar,<sup>1</sup> Calendar No. 586. There has been no Senate action on S. 3369.

Neither party sees any significant movement in the immediate future on either HR 6034 or S. 3369.


